

Explorer Safaris

Reminiscent of the expeditions undertaken by the early explorers, a mobile safari is led by a professional guide who is accompanied by a small convoy of camp staff and equipment necessary for a self-contained journey through the wilderness.

The flexibility of a mobile safari allows travellers access to remote wilderness areas, far beyond the reaches of a morning game drive from a lodge. A typical mobile safari may vary between 6 and 10 nights in length, visiting diverse eco systems and spending 2 to 3 nights at any one.

There are a large variety of mobile safaris available, from basic, participation safaris, where guests are required to partake in daily camp chores, to luxury safaris, with all the comforts of a lodge and a service team to manage the camp. Whatever grade of safari you choose, one thing is certain, camping no longer means having to rough it. In fact, even a budget, participation safari offers a level of comfort that most people would not associate with camping in the wild. There is something magical about the atmosphere created by the soft, warm glow of a paraffin lantern, showering under the starry night sky and the flicker and warmth of a campfire.

Fairly long driving distances between camps are typical on a mobile safari, varying between 2 and 6 hours. In some countries we fly between areas. These journeys are generally within the national parks and reserves, therefore one long game drive with a delicious picnic lunch en route and many pit stops. This type of travel allows you to fully appreciate the subtle changes in the environment as you move from one area to the next. The guide will also explain the natural forces which drove these changes and how they shaped the contrasting landscape. The thrill is not only in the destination, but the journey itself.

These trips have a maximum of seven guests, so places are reserved on a first come basis. Speak to us about their departure dates.
